

BYLAW NO. 4362

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF REGINA  
TO CONTROL SKUNKS

---

WHEREAS skunks are a potential danger to the health and welfare of the citizens of the City of Regina and are known to be carriers of rabies and other diseases;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The City of Regina deems it desirable to control skunks within the limits of the City for the purpose of protecting the health and welfare of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the Medical Health Officer of the City shall be in charge of and in control of the eradication of skunks within the City.
2. THAT the Medical Health Officer may engage the services of or the assistance of such person or persons as he may deem advisable in order to eradicate skunks.
3. THAT the Medical Health Officer may authorize such means of exterminating skunks as may be deemed advisable having in mind the safety of the citizens at all times.
4. THAT any member of the Police force of the City and any person engaged by the Medical Health Officer under the provisions of this Bylaw may use and discharge any firearm in order to eradicate skunks notwithstanding the provisions of any other bylaw of the City to the contrary.
5. THAT the Council shall appropriate such sums of money as it may deem advisable in order to enable the Medical Health Officer to carry out the provisions of this Bylaw.
