

BYLAW NO. 9418

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF REGINA TO  
CONSENT TO THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION  
OF BEVERAGE ALCOHOL IN THE AGRIDOME

WHEREAS Section 56 of The Alcohol Control Act, S.S. 1978 c.A18.01 provides that the Liquor Licensing Commission may issue a licence for the sale and consumption of beverage alcohol in a sports stadium; and

WHEREAS the Regina Exhibition Association Limited, desirous of providing for the sale and consumption of beverage alcohol in The Agridome has requested that Council consent to such sale and consumption;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as The Agridome Beverage Alcohol Bylaw, 1992.
2. Beverage alcohol may be sold and consumed at any event held in the Agridome upon those terms and conditions the Liquor Licensing Commission considers expedient.
3. Bylaw No. 8852 is repealed.
4. This Bylaw comes into force upon its passage.
