NOTICE OF PARKING CHANGES IN HILLSDALE

The City of Regina would like to thank those citizens who took the time in responding to the parking questionnaire and attending the pubic meeting held on June 9, 2005. Based on the returned questionnaires and the opinions expressed during the open house, a neighbourhood-based parking strategy has been formulated. The National Fire Code requires access routes for fire response to have a clear width of not less than 6 metres. To facilitate the garbage pick-up trucks and the emergency response vehicles, all roads with pavement width less than 8.7 metres will have parking ban instituted on one side of the road, which affects the following locations:

- 1. Latte Street:
- 2. Darke Crescent;
- 3. Bole Place;
- 4. Dunning Crescent; and
- 5. Langley Street.

To provide residents with on-street parking overnight and weekends, parking will be allowed on one side of the road from Monday to Friday between 6 p.m. and 8 a.m. for the following locations:

- 1. McNiven Avenue from Martin Street to Darke Crescent;
- 2. McNiven Place; and
- 3. Darke Crescent.

To discourage University students from parking in the Hillsdale neighbourhood, new 2-hour parking restriction from Monday to Friday between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m. will be installed for the following locations:

- 1. Both sides of Jubilee Avenue between Langley Street and Hillsdale Street;
- 2. One side of Langley Street; and
- 3. One side of Dunning Crescent.
