Re: Access to Information Request #2017-049 – Cafeteria Renovations

This is further our letter dated May 26, 2017 regarding third party notification related to your access to information request received by the City on May 26, 2017, quoted as follows:

“Please provide all financial analysis of proposed cafeteria renovations at City Hall, including, but not limited to: budgets, cost estimates, revenue projections, etc.”

The City has received no objections from the third party for release of the records. Enclosed is a copy of Stantec City of Regina City Hall Food Services – Preliminary Budget & Spatial Requirements dated March 18, 2010.

Also enclosed is a City Council report CR12-21 dated February 21, 2012 where funding for the main floor renovation was requested and approved. In terms of construction costs, please note this is a bundled infrastructure upgrade project for the construction for the entire main floor, which includes the area dedicated to food and beverage service.

If you wish to exercise your right to request a review of this decision, you may do so by completing a Request for Review form and forwarding it to the Saskatchewan Information and Privacy Commissioner within one year of this notice.
