

BYLAW NO. 5883

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF REGINA TO
PROHIBIT AND REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE USE OF BARBED WIRE WITHIN THE
CITY OF REGINA

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT no person shall use barbed wire for the purpose of a fence or other protective manner within the limits of the City of Regina at a height below six (6) feet from ground level.
2. THAT notwithstanding anything above, no barbed wire shall protrude upon a public highway including sidewalks and boulevards but must be wholly situated upon the owner's property.
3. THAT any person convicted of a breach of the provisions of this Bylaw shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Provincial Magistrate or Justice of the Peace having jurisdiction in The City of Regina, a penalty not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) exclusive of costs and upon default of payment thereof, the person convicted may be committed to a jail, the guard-room of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or to a public lock-up for any time determined by the said Provincial Magistrate or Justice of the Peace not exceeding thirty (30) days unless the penalty and costs including the costs of committal and of the conveyance of the person convicted to the said jail, guard-room or lock-up are sooner paid.

READ A FIRST TIME THE 14th DAY OF SEPTEMBER A.D. 1976;

READ A SECOND TIME THE 14th DAY OF SEPTEMBER A.D. 1976;

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED THE 14th DAY OF SEPTEMBER A.D. 1976.
