

BYLAW NO. 9509

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF REGINA
TO ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF
WARDS IN THE CITY OF REGINA

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Regina at a regular meeting held on the 10th day of December 1936 passed Bylaw No. 1887, which provided that the number of councillors to be elected from the whole City be ten (10) and that they be elected by a general vote of the electors; and

WHEREAS Section 25 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 (as amended by The Urban Municipality Amendment Act, 1993) requires the establishment of wards to ensure that the councillors to be elected at the next general municipal election are elected to represent the wards into which the City is divided;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as The Establishment of Wards Bylaw, 1993.
2. The City of Regina is divided into ten (10) wards.
3. The wards are numbered one (1) to ten (10), both numbers inclusive.
4. The City Clerk apply to the Minister of Municipal Government to have the boundaries established for the wards designed in Section 2 by a Municipal Wards Commission.
5. The City Manager shall determine and cause to be paid the remuneration and expenses of the members of the Municipal Wards Commission.
6. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.
