If a submission does get approved and displays on the page, but your team decides it's unacceptable, both Wayne and I can contact the service team and have them remove it asap.

Here's [Bang the Table's moderation policy](#). It's long, so to summarize, here's what they won't allow:

1. Don't defame anyone or any organization. A comment is defamatory if it lowers or harms the reputation of a person or organization.
2. Don't post anything that could be considered intolerant of a person's race, culture, appearance, gender, sexual preference, religion or age.
3. Don't be obscene and don't use foul language. Disguising swear words by deliberately misspelling them doesn't make them any less offensive.
4. Don't personally insult or harass other participants.
5. Don't post or link to any inappropriate, offensive or illegal material. Don't post any advertisements.

Dear Mayor Masters and Members of Regina City Council:

RE: Sir John A. Macdonald's Statue in Victoria Park

I understand that, on Wednesday, City Council will consider whether the historic statue of Prime Minister Sir John A. Macdonald should be removed from Victoria Park. As a parliamentarian representing Saskatchewan in the Senate of Canada, and as a longtime citizen of the city of Regina, I strongly urge you to ensure Sir John A. Macdonald's statue remains in place in Victoria Park as an enduring symbol of the promise offered by Confederation.

As our first Prime Minister, Sir John A. Macdonald holds a special place in Canadian history. Without Macdonald's pragmatism, skill, and determination, Canada would likely never have coalesced into one great and strong nation - a nation forged from negotiation and compromise, committed to "peace, order, and good government." Macdonald also brought to life his vision of a transcontinental railway spanning and uniting the country. This was vital for the development of western Canada (including Regina).

Of course, our nation's leaders and heroes are not without flaws, and Macdonald is no exception. All leaders are, in some way, the product of their time. From the twenty-first century, we can look upon Sir John A. Macdonald's legacy with the advantage of hindsight. From here, we see the consequences of his decisions and policies, affirmed or otherwise. But we cannot supplant his historical context - his values, his judgments - with those prevalent in our own modern time.

Traditionally, history has been written by the victors, and that has meant other heroes, other stories, other viewpoints and perspectives have been ignored, neglected, or overlooked. We cannot - we must not - erase our history. But we should add to it, and we should give it full context.

Reconciliation with Canada's past must be thoughtful and meaningful. It will be borne from neither destruction nor denial, but from understanding. Let's find creative ways to tell the full history of Canada, including the creation of new monuments and public art works to express the rich history and stories of Canada's Indigenous peoples. Reconciliation will only be possible if Canadians, Indigenous and non-Indigenous alike, respectfully learn about one another's histories.


The statue of John A. Macdonald in Victoria Park is an important symbol of our commitment to Canadian sovereignty and national unity. It reminds all of us what can be achieved through negotiation and patience. For these reasons, I ask that you preserve the Macdonald monument where it is, and that we focus our efforts on creating a more inclusive historical context through additional artworks or monuments.

The Sir John A. Macdonald statue was removed from Regina's Victoria Park on Wednesday morning.

The City of Regina said the removal of the statue was not publicized for security reasons and to ensure the area could be kept safe for staff.

It said a public art collection curator was on site to make sure the statue was handled properly. The statue was to be moved into storage until it can be reinstalled in a new location, with additional context.

Regina's city council voted seven to four on March 31 to remove the statue. Public consultation will be done over the next few months, including through an [online survey on Be Heard Regina](#).

A recent report by city administrators said the statue overlooks the negative impacts Macdonald's policies and initiatives have had on Indigenous Peoples.

"These policies include use of day schools and residential schools as tools of assimilation, relocation of Indigenous Peoples away from traditional hunting and fishing areas to make room for European settlement, and an inadequate and often corrupt system for delivering rations to reserves," the report said.

**This morning, the Sir John A. Macdonald statue was moved from Victoria Park into temporary storage, in accordance with City Council's direction on March 31, 2021.**

**A public art collection curator was on site to ensure that the statue was properly handled and safely transported to storage until it can be re-installed in a new location. On the morning of Tuesday, April 13, the Sir John A. Macdonald statue was moved from Victoria Park into temporary storage, in accordance with City Council's direction on March 31, 2021. The date of the move was not released in advance due to security reasons and to ensure the area could be kept safe as the work was completed. A public art collection curator was on site to ensure that the statue was properly handled and safely transported to storage until it can be re-installed in a new location. The City will continue to explore new locations for the statue where additional context about Macdonald's legacy can be added. A recommendation is to be before City Council by early 2022.

Dear Mayor Masters and Members of Regina City Council:

RE: Sir John A. Macdonald's Statue in Victoria Park

I understand that, on Wednesday, City Council will consider whether the historic statue of Prime Minister Sir John A. Macdonald should be removed from Victoria Park. As a parliamentarian representing Saskatchewan in the Senate of Canada, and as a longtime citizen of the city of Regina, I strongly urge you to ensure Sir John A. Macdonald's statue remains in place in Victoria Park as an enduring symbol of the promise offered by Confederation.

As our first Prime Minister, Sir John A. Macdonald holds a special place in Canadian history. Without Macdonald's pragmatism, skill, and determination, Canada would likely never have coalesced into one great and strong nation - a nation forged from negotiation and compromise, committed to "peace, order, and good government." Macdonald also brought to life his vision of a transcontinental railway spanning and uniting the country. This was vital for the development of western Canada (including Regina).

Of course, our nation's leaders and heroes are not without flaws, and Macdonald is no exception. All leaders are, in some way, the product of their time. From the twenty-first century, we can look upon Sir John A. Macdonald's legacy with the advantage of hindsight. From here, we see the consequences of his decisions and policies, affirmed or otherwise. But we cannot suppress his historical context - his values, his judgments - with those prevalent in our own modern times.

Traditionally, history has been written by the victors, and that has meant other heroes, other stories, other viewpoints and perspectives have been ignored, neglected, or overlooked. We cannot - we must not - erase our history. But we should add to it, and we should give it full context.

Reconciliation with Canada's past must be thoughtful and meaningful. It will be borne from neither destruction nor denial, but from understanding. Let's find creative ways to tell the full history of Canada, including the creation of new monuments and public art works to express the rich history and stories of Canada's Indigenous peoples. Reconciliation will only be possible if Canadians, Indigenous and non-Indigenous alike, respectfully learn about one another's histories.

The statue of John A. Macdonald in Victoria Park is an important symbol of our commitment to Canadian sovereignty and national unity. It reminds all of us what can be achieved through negotiation and patience. For these reasons, I ask that you preserve the Macdonald monument where it is, and that we focus our efforts on creating a more inclusive historical context through additional artworks or monuments.






