

BYLAW NO. 10068

THE FREDERICK W. HILL MALL DESIGNATION
AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS BYLAW, 1998

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REGINA ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as *The Frederick W. Hill Mall Bylaw*.
2. The pedestrian mall consisting of that portion of all of Scarth Street lying between a line joining the southwest corner of Block 306 to the southeast corner of Block 307, and a line joining the northwest corner of Block 306 to the northeast corner of Block 307 as shown on Registered Plan Old No. 33, established by Bylaw No. 5595, is hereby continued as a pedestrian mall.
3. The pedestrian mall continued in section 1 is hereby designated and shall henceforth be known as “The Frederick W. Hill Mall”.
4. The City Manager is authorized to take such action as in his opinion is necessary and desirable to provide public signification of the designation of the Frederick W. Hill Mall.
5.
 - (1) Bylaw No. 9900, being *The Regina Traffic Bylaw, 1997*, is amended in the manner set forth in this section.
 - (2) Section 1 is amended:
 - (a) by repealing the definition of “Scarth Street Mall”; and
 - (b) by adding the following definition after the definition of “emergency vehicle”:

“ **Frederick W. Hill Mall**’ means that portion of all of Scarth Street lying between a line joining the southwest corner of Block 306 to the southeast corner of Block 307 and a line joining the northwest corner of Block 306 to the northeast corner of Block 307 as shown on Registered Plan Old No. 33;”.
 - (3) Section 94 and the heading “Scarth Street Mall Continued” preceding section 94 are repealed and the following substituted:

“Mall on Scarth Street

94. The mall on Scarth Street established by Bylaw No. 5595 as a pedestrian mall pursuant to subsection 155(4) of *The Urban Municipality Act, 1984*, is hereby continued as a pedestrian mall under the name of The Frederick W. Hill Mall.”
6. (1) Bylaw No. 9881, being *The Regina Clean Property Bylaw, 1997*, is amended in the manner set forth in this section.
- (2) Section 1 is amended:
- (a) by repealing the definition of “Scarth Street Mall”; and
- (b) by adding the following definition after the definition of “Director”:
- “ **‘Frederick W. Hill Mall’** means that portion of all of Scarth Street lying between a line joining the southwest corner of Block 306 to the southeast corner of Block 307, and a line joining the northwest corner of Block 306 to the northeast corner of Block 307, as shown on Registered Plan Old No. 33.”.
- (3) Section 5.1 is amended:
- (a) by striking out the heading “Scarth Street Mall” preceding section 5.1 and substituting the heading “Frederick W. Hill Mall”; and
- (b) in subsection (1), by striking out “Scarth Street Mall” and substituting “Frederick W. Hill Mall”.
7. This Bylaw comes into force on the day of passage.
