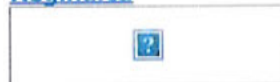

I am an Indigenous person and I find it disturbing 28(1) 28(1) 28(1) 28(1) 28(1) ! After 150+ years of colonialism and government policies that sought to destroy Indigenous communities like residential schools and the Sixties Scoop, why not focus on actions that will support healing and wellness so that Indigenous people can heal and live in this society together with non-Indigenous citizens? Colonialism never leaves Indigenous inhabitants in a healthy position. All you have to do to know this is true is look at the social and economic indicators of Indigenous people of New Zealand, Australia, United States, and countries in the African continent that have been colonised by European countries. The issue of Indigenous homelessness is a broader and deeper

issue caused by colonisation and systemic marginalisation through government policies. This issue is so much more complex and entrenched than "some people in the Indigenous culture don't want to have homes". What about the mental health issues from the legacy of residential schools and the destruction that this policy and others like it have had on Indigenous families?²⁸⁽¹⁾

²⁸⁽¹⁾ Has city council not had any anti-racist education or Aboriginal Awareness training? I thought the City was committed to reconciliation. This was a missed opportunity to demonstrate that.

Your Message
You asked about people choosing to be homeless, I hope this will give you some insight.
28(1) I worked for years with Indigenous people who could not or would not be housed. They lived itinerant lifestyles by choice. While this was likely partially due to intergenerational trauma, I believe it was also based on culture. Before Europeans came with the concept that home was a fixed location, these were people who lived nomadic lifestyles. However the settler idea of what such a lifestyle means makes it difficult for those who prefer it to admit it. They are not choosing to be homeless necessarily, rather, they like the freedom to be nomadic. There are people of European descent that prefer this lifestyle too. But there is an added stigma about Indigenous people who do so. The idea is that being homeless is bad therefore choosing not to have a fixed address makes you bad and worthless. Homelessness will never be "fixed" until everyone can recognize that the concept is as normative as expecting everyone to be "straight" or even binary. One

solution will be hostel-like shelters where people can drop in when they need a home but free to come and go when they please. I don't know when or if people will be ready to accept that.
