You asked about people choosing to be homeless, I hope this will give you some insight.

worked for years with Indigenous people who could not or would not be housed. They lived itinerant lifestyles by choice. While this was likely partially due to intergenerational trauma, I believe it was also based on culture. Before Europeans came with the concept that home was a fixed location, these were people who lived nomadic lifestyles. However the settler idea of what such a lifestyle means makes it difficult for those who prefer it to admit it. They are not choosing to be homeless necessarily, rather, they like the freedom Message to be nomadic. There are people of European descent that prefer this lifestyle too. But there is an added stigma about Indigenous people who do so. The idea is that being homeless is bad therefore choosing not to have a fixed address makes you bad and worthless.
