Re: Underground Storage Tanks X 4 – 445 Winnipeg Street, Regina, SK (Serm Facility

On a recent inspection of the above mentioned premises, the following condition was noted:

1. There are unused underground storage tanks at the above location.

You are hereby notified to remove this or these tanks on or before __August 15, 2002__ in compliance with the National Fire Code of Canada 1995, Part 4 Subsection 4.10.3 and The City of Regina By-law 9923 "Removal of Underground Storage Tanks".

- 4.10.3.1(1) When underground storage tanks are out of service:
- (a) Such tanks, together with connected piping and dispensing equipment shall have flammable and combustible liquids removed from them.
- (b) Such tanks shall be removed from the ground and purged of vapours and
- (c) The piping shall be:
 - removed from the ground or (i)
 - purged of vapours and the ends permanently sealed by capping or plugging. (ii)
- 2. Contaminated soil surrounding the storage tank/s must be replaced with clean fill.
- 3. A closure report must be submitted to this office.
- 4. This department must be notified at least 48 hours prior to removal or installation of the tanks

A building permit must be obtained from the City of Regina for the installation, removal or modification of aboveground/underground storage tanks.

Approval is also required from Saskatchewan Environment.

Thank you for your cooperation in matters of fire safety.
