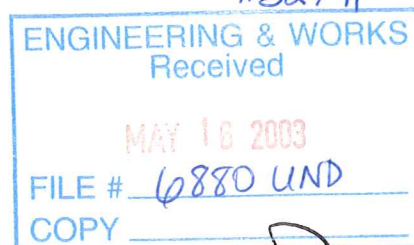

**Re: Closure Report on Underground Storage Tank Removal
- 445 Winnipeg Street, Regina SK**

Saskatchewan Environment has received and reviewed the closure report on underground storage tank removal submitted by Golder Associates Ltd. in regards to the above noted facility and offers the following comments.

The report stated four (4) underground storage tanks (UST) were removed from the site, however, petroleum hydrocarbon contamination in excess of the departments 1995 commercial / industrial criteria remains in both UST nest excavations.

The Hazardous Substances and Waste Dangerous Goods Regulations requires owners of storage facilities to decontaminate and reclaim the affected area; to monitor and manage the affected area; or a combination of decontaminating and reclaiming and monitoring and managing the affected area.

Please forward to this department, once available, Agrifoods International Cooperative Ltd.'s plans to decommission the affected area.
