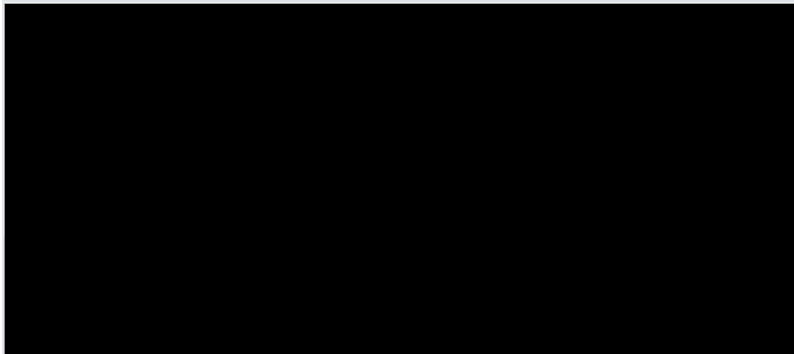

Hi, Dan,

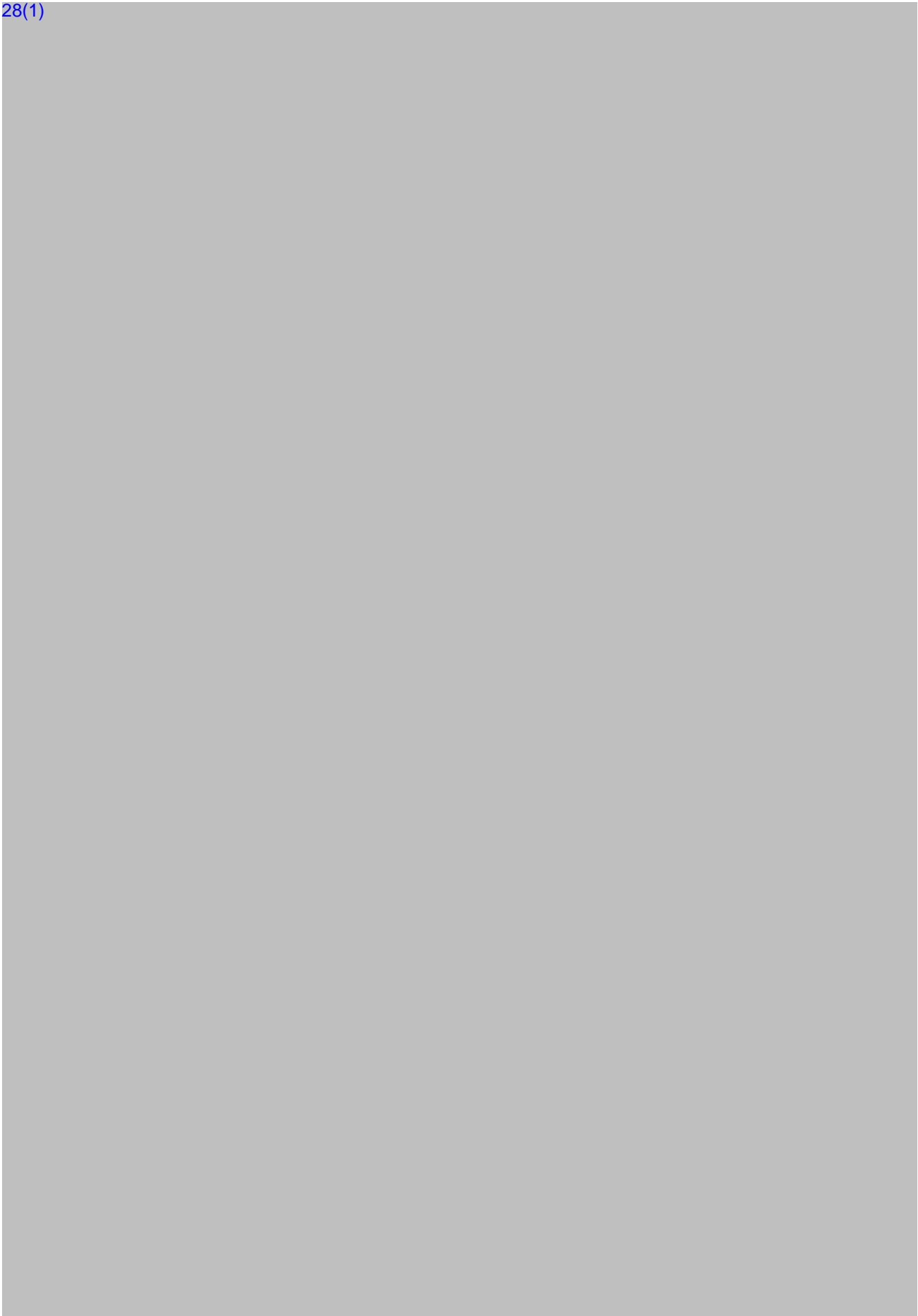

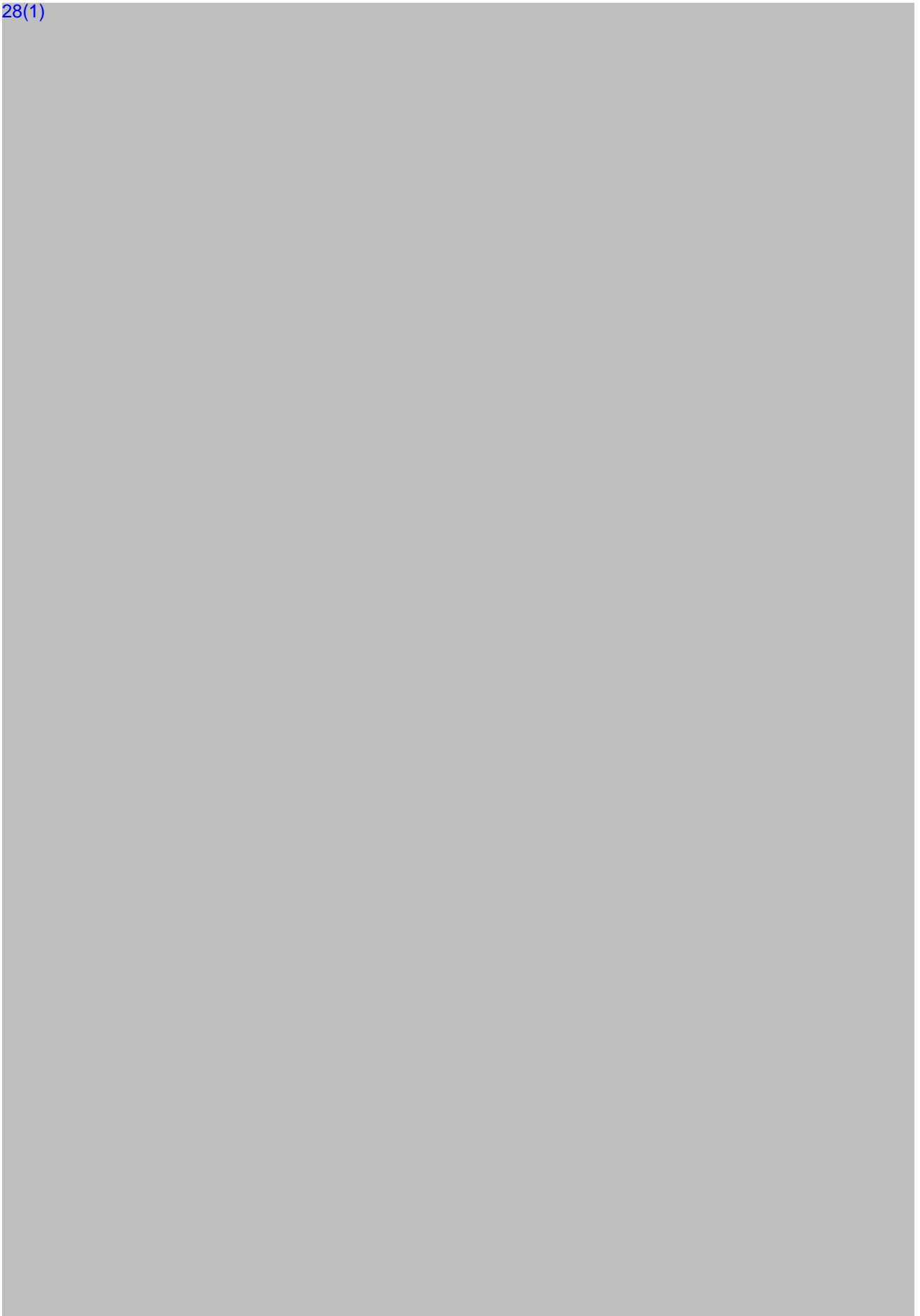
