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

<u>BACKGROUND</u>

A subcommittee of the Mayor's Task Force on Regina's Future has been working on a project to create a representation of the "I Love Regina" logo to be placed in front of City Hall in Queen Elizabeth II Court. This idea was discussed and endorsed by City Council on December 15, 2003. The original plan was to place the structure inside the fountain but because of concerns of rusting, the proposal now is for it to be placed between the fountain and the flag poles. A picture of the proposed design, as well as a map of the Courtyard showing where the structure will be located, are attached to this report. Community representatives from Brandt Industries and SIAST have offered to create the structure. The purpose of this report is to recommend approval of the new design and location by City Council.

DISCUSSION

Members of the Task Force on Regina's Future have discussed the idea for this structure and have given their support in principle. The Task Force sees it as an excellent addition to the "I Love Regina" campaign. While Brandt Industries and SIAST will pay for the materials and labour to build the structure, the City would be responsible for costs and labour involved with constructing the concrete base and installation.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Costs are estimated at \$10,000, which would be absorbed by the Corporate Services maintenance Budget for City Hall.

COMMUNICATION PLAN

Mr. Joseph Pettick of Pettick Phillips Partners Architects Ltd., who was the architect of the Queen Elizabeth II Courtyard, will receive a copy of this report and City Council's decision.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPLICATIONS

None for this report.

CONCLUSION

The creation and installation of an "I Love Regina" structure in front of City Hall will assist in promoting community pride, here at home and for our visitors. The structure will be a source of pride for visitors alike for photo opportunities and tourism. This initiative demonstrates a partnership with our community leaders, Brandt Industries and SIAST, another successful example of civic pride.

RECOMMENDATION

1. That the design, costs and location of an "I Love Regina" Structure in QEII, as outlined in this report, be approved.
