Re: Parking Enforcement & Scheduling Services Contract - RFP Selection Team Ratings

Six submissions were received in response to the Parking Enforcement and Enforcement Scheduling Services RFP. The Parking Enforcement Selection Committee met on June 5, 2013 to review the six submissions, and determined that the Canadian Corps of Commissionaires scored the highest on our rating scale. Therefore, the rating team recommends that the Canadian Corps of Commissionaires, South Saskatchewan Division be awarded the Parking Enforcement contract starting June 21, 2013 until May 31, 2016, with two (2) one year extensions at the option of the City.
